# PRAYER POINTS

## DAY 1

Heavenly Father, we pray for you to intervene to **stop the spread of the coronavirus**. We pray in Jesus' name that the virus would recede and diminish from this day forward, and that the numbers of those infected would decline rapidly. We trust you, Lord, to intervene today, we thank you for the power of your word as we declare it in faith. We are confident in our authority in Your Name to speak to the virus and command it to stop.

**1 John 5: 14** And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to his will he hears us. And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of him.

## DAY 2

Pray for **those who are sick**, that they will be healed in Jesus Name and also they will have access to the care and treatment they need. We pray peace and strength over them. We also pray for those in isolation who are cut off from their normal routines and support systems, that they would seek their strength from you, that depression, anxiety and fear would not come near their door in Jesus Name. We pray encouragement over the thousands in quarantine and that fear would not grip their hearts or minds.

**Psalm 46: 1** God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

## DAY 3

Pray for the **health workers** who are caring for those with COVID-19. We pray for their protection from the virus, for stamina during long or intense work hours, and for safe protocols to be observed in healthcare institutions in order to keep them protected. We pray for health workers to seek you during this crisis. Lord we pray that you would send labourer's across their path so that they would hear the gospel message.

**Psalm 107: 28** Then they cried to the LORD in their trouble, and he delivered them from their distress.



## DAY 4

Pray for **grieving families** who have lost loved ones to the coronavirus. Even as their hearts are breaking, we pray they would know your comfort and peace and that You are a very present help in times of trouble. We pray that your compassion would be felt through the Holy Spirit's ministry and through the ministry of friends and neighbours who come around them. We pray against despair; we pray new mercies every morning.

**Philippians 4: 6-7** Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

## DAY 5

Pray for **Pastors and leaders** serving their churches and communities affected and infected by COVID-19. We pray that the Holy Spirit would give these shepherd leaders the right words for the right time and the right actions for the right situation. We pray they would continue to preach the gospel message and teach the un-compromised word of God with power and authority with signs following and to see the sick healed. We pray for a hedge of protection around them and their families.

**James 5: 14, 16** Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. ... The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.

## DAY 6

Pray for **the Body of Christ worldwide**, that the church would rise up in authority and boldness. We pray for the church to be a light on a hill in our towns and cities, in our hospitals and communities where you have placed us. We pray for an outpouring of love, compassion and service, in Your Name. We pray for a spirit of unity amongst believers knowing that when we pray the prayer of agreement, You are in the midst.

**1 Corinthians 12: 24-27** But God has composed the body and has given greater honour to the parts that lacked it, so that there should be no division in the body, but that its members should have mutual concern for one another. If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honoured, every part rejoices with it. Now you are the body of Christ, and each of you is a member of it.



## DAY 7

Pray for **government officials and decision makers** who are leading countries and organisations through the crisis. We acknowledge you have allowed each one to be in a place of authority during this time. We pray they would mobilise resources quickly and effectively to where they are most urgently needed. We specifically pray for our Prime Minister Boris Johnson and his cabinet that you would give them great wisdom and knowledge at this time. We pray for good administration and execution of response efforts worldwide.

**Jeremiah 29: 7** Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the LORD for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper.

## DAY 8

Pray for **those affected financially by COVID-19**, that they would reach out, rely on and trust in the Lord. We pray for people to seek You earnestly and know You Lord as their source. We pray for those whose businesses and livelihoods may be effected by the current financial situation and those who may lose jobs or incomes. We pray that they continue to tithe and sow and that they would not loose their confidence in Your Word that declares You will rebuke the devourer on their behalf. For each one, we pray new beginnings, new dreams and fresh vision.

**Jeremiah 29: 11, 12** "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you."

## DAY 9

Pray for the **five fold ministry and lay ministers** worldwide, especially those serving in areas acutely impacted by COVID-19. We pray for wisdom concerning their ministry. We also pray that ministries would not have to shut down, but that you would protect them through this difficult time for your glory. We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed.

## DAY 10

**Pray for all those who don't know you**, that they would come to the full knowledge of Jesus Christ and that they would know your love. We pray the gift of salvation for every man, woman and child around the world today. We are asking in Your Name for the gift of salvation to come out of this crisis.

**2 Peter 3:9** The Lord is not slow to fulfil his promise as some understand slowness but is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish but everyone to come to repentance.
